A Music Education Partnership Between the Memphis Symphony Orchestra, Shelby County Schools the Public Library System, Tunes and Tales is a reading-enriched musical series for young children. Each concert is based on one children's book, with musicians and a narrator telling the story through music. Children learn how composers use music to tell stories through the instrument families of the Orchestra; strings, brass, winds and percussion.

After each performance, children have the opportunity to engage with crafts or activities to further their learning and respond to the music they have just heard.
